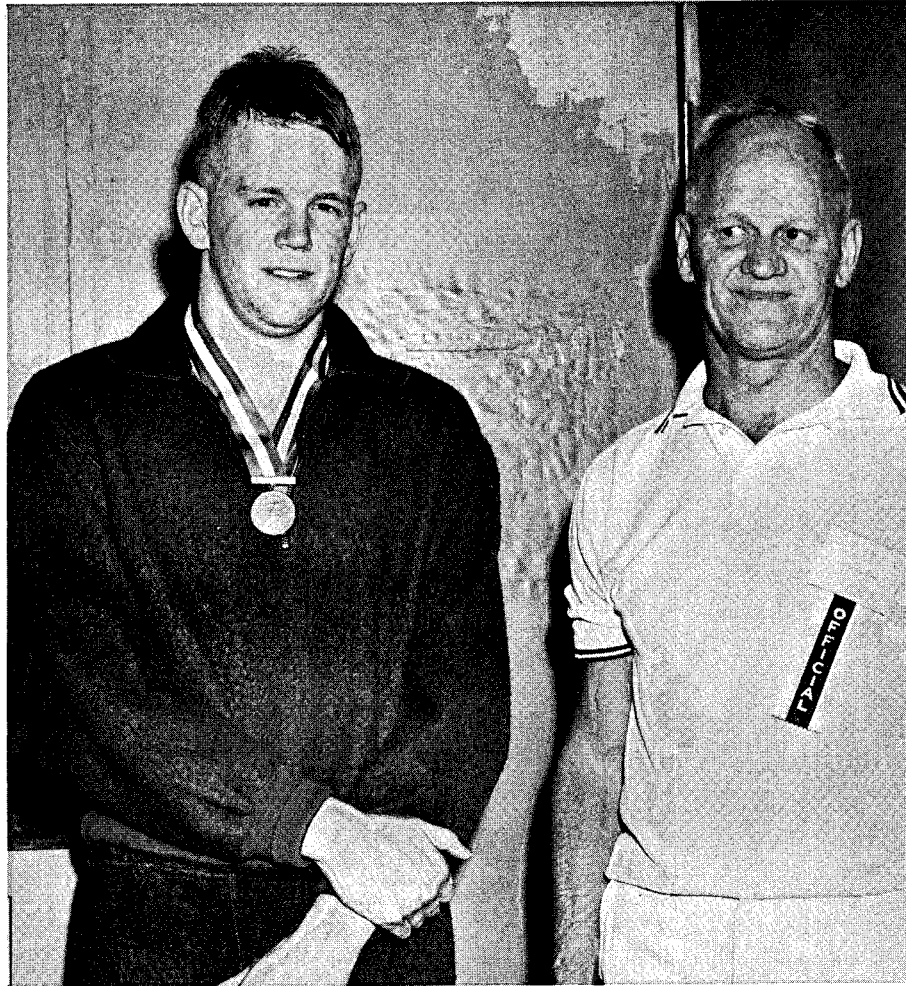


CALIFORNIA DISTANCE SWIMMERS TO

SAARI . . . SCHOOLBOY BEST

California, long regarded as the spawning ground of great national ranking swimmers, dominated 1962 High School All-America selections as compiled by Ray Mondo, Highland Park, Michigan, Chairman of the National Interscholastic Swimming Coaches Assoc. Selection Committee.

So strong in depth were the mermen from California, that in the freestyle middle distances and individual medley events half of the 20 selected for each event came from the Golden State, and the majority of that state's selections were developed in the Southern CIF district.

But if California claimed to have the country's best, other states were within striking distance. Illinois, long a hot-bed of outstanding scholastic swimming, and traditionally rich in high caliber competition in Evanston-New Trier-Hinsdale area, Michigan, Florida and Ohio also showed solid depth with Pennsylvania, New Jersey, New York and Texas not far behind. And this latter group placed at least one man in almost every event.

Oklahoma surprised, as they splashed into the national picture, and Maryland, through the efforts of one schoolboy, gained mention in the High School Honor Roll of Swimming.

Individually, it was a climax of a fantastic year for Roy Saari, 17 year old El Segundo, California senior. Saari ranked first in four individual events, established three Interscholastic records and received mention in two other events (100 yard backstroke and 50 yard freestyle) supporting his claim as the best U.S. High School swimmer of 1962.

Saari, headed for University of Southern California, gave full credit to Urho, his father-coach at El Segundo High, who turned credits water-polo as one of the prime conditioners necessary for today's top performances.

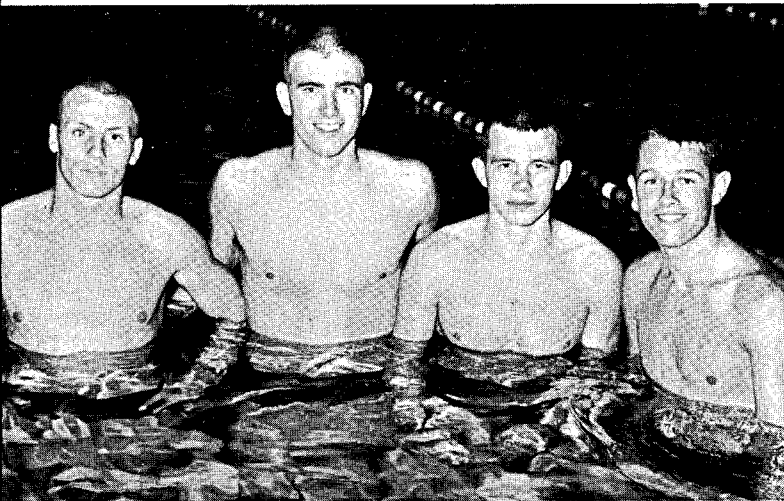
In the 400 yard freestyle Saari led California sweep of the first six places, his time 3:53.9, a record for the event, being far ahead of Dean Williford, Downey 3:57.7; Bill Farley, St. Francis, 3:58.5; Dick Rotter, sophomore from Atherton, 3:58.9; Lee Danielson, Notre Dame, Sherman Oaks 3:59; Mike Wall junior at Blackford, Sa

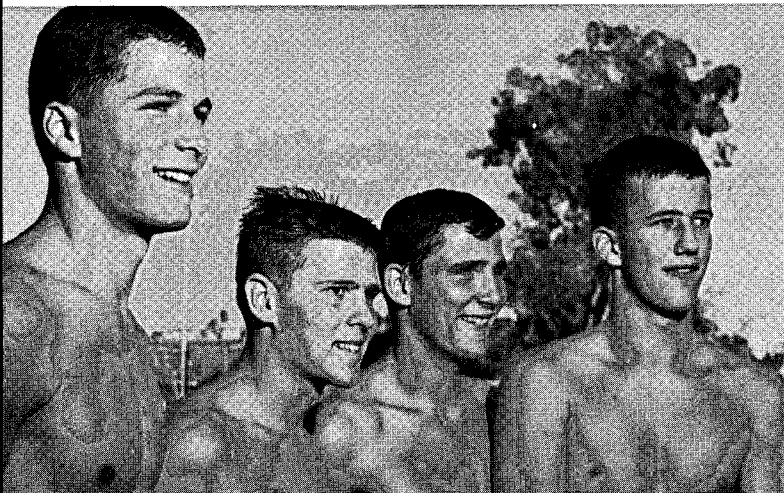

Jose, 3:59.5 and Tom Diefenderfer, Santa Clara 4:02.4. All but Diefenderfer and Roth were from the Southern California area. Bubba Tongay, Jackson High, Miami was the first non-Californian to earn All America recognition in the event with a 4:03.5 clocking to his credit, as three more California based high school boys broke into the list of twenty.

In the 100 yard freestyle, the El Segundo 3-time National AAU Indoor Champion, recorded a time of :48.7 just a little more than a second faster than Gary Ilman, James Lick High School, San Jose, :48.9. Bob Williamson, Tonowanda, New York, clocked 3rd best time, :49.3 followed by Dick Jacobberger, Berkeley :49.8; Tom Pringle, Evans-ton, :49.8.

The 200 yard freestyle almost duplicated the 400 yard event as Hinsdale, Illinois Scott Cordin's 1:51.1 stopped a California whitewash of the first six places. Roy, perched at the top of the 8-lap event with a Interscholastic record of 1:46.6 followed by Bill Farley and crosstown rival Dean Williford, both tied at 1:49.0. Then it was Lee Danielson and Mike Wall, both at 1:50.5, followed by Cordin. The West Coast state dominated the event so solidly that they placed eleven out of the twenty All-Americans, with only five states, Illinois (3), Florida (2), Oklahoma (2), New York and Pennsylvania one each, able to gain national honors.

Saari's third 1st place ranking came in the 200 yard individual medley as he led all high school swimmers in the four stroke event, 2:01.8, an Interscholastic record.

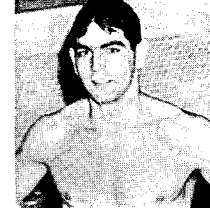
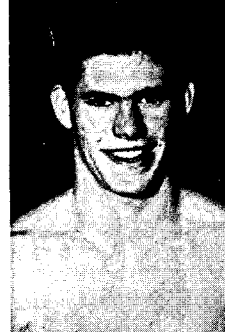
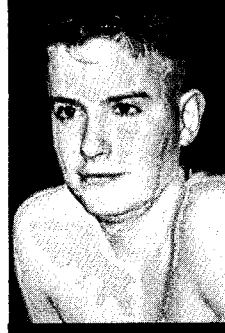
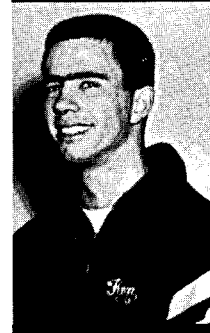
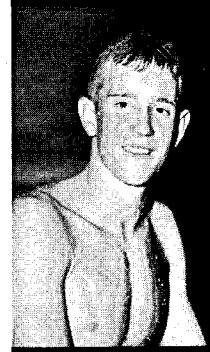
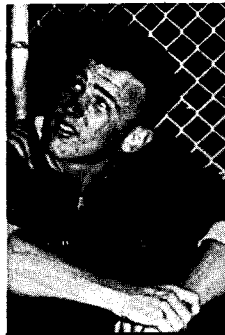
Bill Utley, Odessa, Texas by way of Indianapolis was second, 2:04.1. Charles Gantner, Piscataway, New Jersey, 2:05.3 earned the third ranking followed by a pair of Californians tied for fourth, Bob Hopper, a junior at Arcadia and Karl McCrary, Palo Alto, 2:02.6.

Rich McGeagh, Hoover-Glendale, Calif., and Bob Williamson Tonowanda, N.Y., tied for the fastest 50-yard freestyle, :21.9. Baltimore's Philip Denkewitz, Poly, :22.0; Bill Groft, York, Pa. :22.1; Rich Hollister, Dieruff-Allentown and Brad Lindeblad, Broward-Florida both at :22.2 filled out the top six. Michigan swimmers though not in the top six made their best showing with six All America placements in this event.

McGeagh established an Interscholastic High School mark of :54.5 in placing first in the 100 yard backstroke. This time bettered the time of a pair of Illinois dorsal stars, Pete Hammer, Evanston and George Goff, Proviso East-Maywood, both tied at :54.9. Another Illini, Rees Orland, Moline, claimed 4th ranking :56.1 followed by John Leasure, McKinley-Canton, Ohio, :56.6; Mike Forrest, Garden Grove, Calif., :57.1.

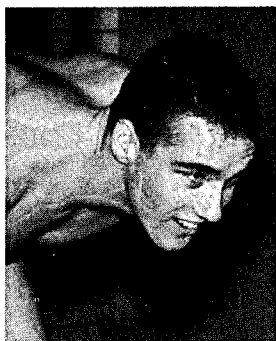
Gary Ilman, James Lick, San Jose, Calif. was the kingpin in the butterfly, clocking :53.2. South Bend's Dave Buchanan, Riley, :54.2 had the second best time followed by Phil Riker, Eastside-Patterson, N.J. and John White, Edgewater-Orlando, Fla. both :54.4 for third best. Donn Spencer, Seaholm-Birmingham, Mich. :54.5 and John Sato, Los Angeles, :54.6 rounded out the best six.

Dick Schaible, Los Altos, Calif. just did snag first place breaststroke on National

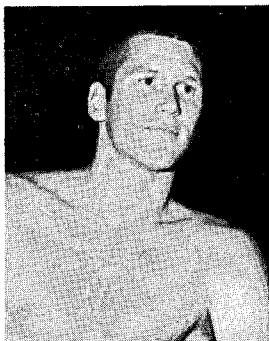


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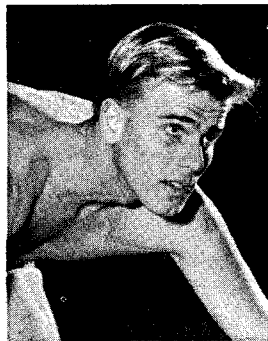

JACKMAN'S 4 EVENTS LEADS NCAA ALL-AMERICA

Ed. Note: G. Robert Mowerson has been selected as the replacement for Bill Huesner at the University of Minnesota. Starting in September, Mowerson will be located in Minneapolis as the head Coach of swimming. Mowerson leaves Michigan State where he served as the assistant to Charles MacCaffree, Jr. Assisting Mowerson will be Ron O'Brien, who will be the diving Coach and act as assistant swimming coach. O'Brien reports at the end of September on his release from the army.

East Lansing, Michigan — Steve Jackman, 21 year old junior from University of Minnesota, made the 1962 NCAA All-America Swimming Team in four events to lead all others as 35 universities contributed to the cream of the greatest crop of college swimmers and divers in NCAA history.

This year, the All-America Selection Committee decided that any designation as to place and time would be omitted from the 1962 All-America certificates. It was also decided by the committee that all reference to times would be omitted in release to any publications. The only All-America who will receive special notation on his certificate will be the NCAA winner who will be honored by these words on his certificate.

The committee recognized that the gap between first and tenth in each event is rapidly closing and the time is ripe for up and coming swimmers to stick their heads way out in front of the college group and really give them something to shoot at. Young men who could do this are already making names for themselves and a big break through is due in many events, especially the 100 yard freestyle, and 100 and 200 yard butterfly.

NCAA winners were: Steve Jackman, Minnesota, 50 and 100 yard freestyle; James Spreitzer, Illinois, 220 yard freestyle; Murray Rose, So. Calif., 440 yard and 1500 meter freestyle; Edwin Spencer, North Carolina State, 100 yard butterfly; Arthur Wolfe, Ohio State, 200 yard butterfly; Richard F. Nelson, Michigan, 100 yard breaststroke; Virgil Luken, Minnesota, 200 yard breaststroke; Louis B. Schaefer IV, Ohio State, 100 and 200 yard backstroke; Harley "Marty" Mull, Ohio State, 200 yard Individual medley; Michigan State (J. Mattson, D. Rowe, W. Wood, M. Wood) and Minnesota (J. Bergman, D. Crocker, R. Allen, S. Jackman) tied in 400 yard freestyle relay; Ohio State (L. B. Schaefer, T. Kovacs, A. Wolfe, J. Plain) 400 yard medley relay; Louis Vitucci, Ohio State, 1-meter and 3-meter springboard.

Rank list, 1:02 a mere 1-tenth better than Tom Tretheway, Mt. Lebanon, Pa., 1:02.1, the time of 1:02 ties Tretheway's record set in 1961. Ken Frost, Redwood High, Larkspur, Calif., 1:02.8 was third and all three are reported headed for Indiana University. Fourth seeding went to a pair . . . Bill Craig, Hoover-Glendale and Ricky Nesbit, Highland Park, Dallas 1:03.1. James Spillane, brother of Olympian Joan Spillane, grabbed sixth spot with a 1:03.2. Spillane attends Spring Branch, Houston High.

The relay events were fiercely contested, and the records made in 1961 and seeming safe for a few years didn't hold up a full season.

In the 200 yard medley relay, the old mark of 1:41.2 set by the New Trier High School was erased by the Glendale Hoover quartet of Rich McGeagh, Bill Craig, Rick Russ and Gerry Main, who posted an eye-popping 1:40.7, to anchor their claim as the country's best. Evanston, Ill. 1:43.1; Tonawanda, N.Y. 1:44.2; Santa Clara, Cal., 1:44.3; Garden Grove, Cal. 1:44.8 and Mt. Lebanon, Penn. 1:44.8 rounded out the top six.

In the 200 yard freestyle relay, Atherton, Calif. cracked the mark set by Santa Clara in 1961. Sprinters Greg Buckingham, Bob Laird, John Mortenson and Bob Plate won top ranking in the relay posting a 1:30.0. El Segundo and San Leandro, Cal. 1:31.2; Evanston and Tonawanda, N. Y. 1:31.9 followed in order.

In diving, quality in performance was shared in almost every part of the country. Youngsters like Ken Sitzberger, Fenwick, Oak Park, Ill. (finalist in AAU Indoor Championship) Dicky Morse, Hillwood, Nashville, Tenn., Dicky Chowning, Paschal, Fort Worth, Texas, Larry Anderson, Western, Anaheim, Calif., Greg Smith, Lincoln Park, Mich. and Les Gerber, Springfield, N.J. will be right up in national contention as they pursue their sport in college competition.

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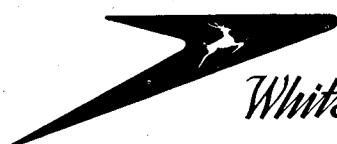

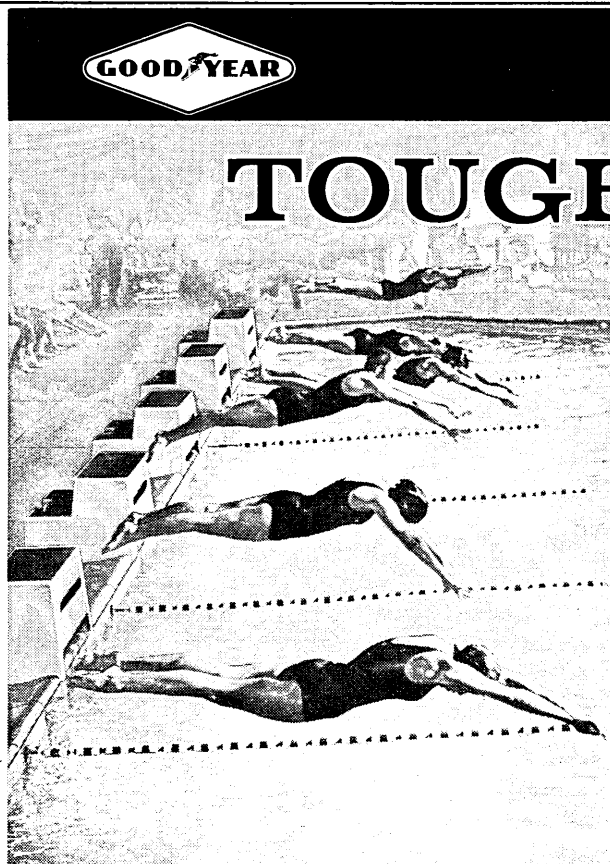

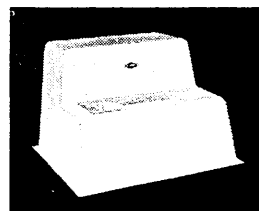
