

CALIFORNIA AGAIN FIRST IN HIGH SCHOOL ALL AMERICA

SCHOLLANDER RANKED FIRST IN FOUR EVENTS

Detroit, Michigan—California again led the nation with placings in 63 individual events and 10 relays in the 1964 National Interscholastic Swimming Coaches Association High School All America.

The listings, compiled by Ralph Deetz, All America Committee Chairman, show that Illinois with a placing in 29 individual events and 10 relays was a strong second followed by Michigan 18 and 8; Penn. 19-3; Florida 11-4; Ohio 12-1; Minn. 5-3; New Jersey 6-2; Conn. 4-1; Wash. 4-0; Kansas 3-0; Iowa 3-0; Missouri 2-0; Texas 2-0; N.Y. 2-0; Colo., Wisc., Okla., New Mex., and Virginia, 1 apiece.

California's dominant strength moved to the Northern part of the state, as swimmers from the Northern CIF made 41 individual listings (plus 1 in diving) and 6 relays.

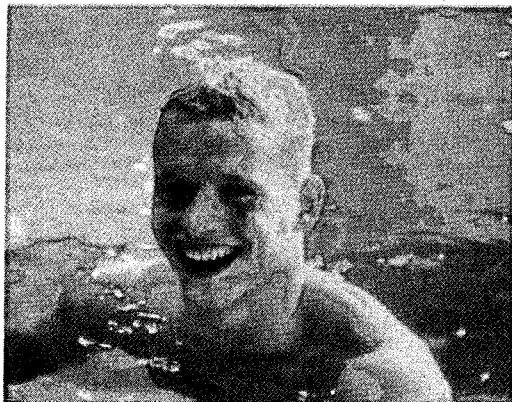
The Southern California CIF picture wasn't too rosey, as their swimmers, limited to high school competitions only during the high school swimming season, dropped to 15 individual and 2 relay (both from the same school) placings.

Central California, with only a fraction of the number of athletes that competed in the Southern District, won 6 individual and 2 relay listings.

Dividing the huge state of California into North and South sections for equitable comparison with the other states placing in the All America, the Northern District continues to hold its premiere spot as the hottest area in the nation. Southern California, for many years equally fertile, now ranks no better than fifth—maybe a notch above Florida, but trailing Illinois, Michigan and Pennsylvania.

In 1965, this ruling will go into effect in the Southern California section of the CIF. "Organized school practice in swimming shall not begin prior to the first day of school in February." Previously, after school practice started on the first day of school in January. There is a report that the swimming coaches from the Southern Section of the CIF will appeal for rescission of this rule at the fall council meeting. This new ruling can't help improve the Southern California CIF swimming picture.

Three records were set in this year's competition: 200 yd. freestyle 1:44.6 (Schollander); 400 yd. freestyle 3:42.2 (Schollander); and 200 yd. individual medley 1:59.7 (Roth).



DON SCHOLLANDER

Santa Clara High School's Don Schollander was a one-man gang, as he placed in every individual swimming event except the breaststroke. The blonde schoolboy placed first in the 100 yd. freestyle (47.9), 200 yd. freestyle (1:44.6), 400 yd. freestyle (3:42.2), 100 yd. butterfly (53.0), third in the 200 yd. individual medley (2:02.7) and 100 yd. backstroke (55.4) and 7th in the 50 yd. freestyle (22.2).

Tom Call, Upper Arlington, Ohio, ranked first in the 50 yd. freestyle, 21.8, as David Gibson, Arthur Hill, Saginaw, Mich., Zac Zorn, Buena Park, Calif., and Brad Lindeblad, South Broward, Fla., each clocked 22.0.

Dick Roth, a junior at Menlo Atherton, Calif., placed first in the 200 yd. individual medley, 1:59.7 followed by Palo Alto's Mike Siebert, 2:02.4. Roth also made mention in the 200 yd. freestyle (5th—1:48.6); 100 yd. butterfly (tied for 8th—54.2); 100 yd. freestyle (11th—49.2); 400 yd. freestyle (tied for 4th—3:56.0) and 100 yd. breaststroke (tied for 9th—1:03.6).

Richard Grants, Moline, Ill., and Pat MacLean, John Marshall, Minn., tied for first place ranking in the 100 yd. backstroke, 55.2.

Frank Freeman, Dearborn Fordson, Mich., grabbed the top spot in the 100 yd. breaststroke, 1:01.7 followed by Azusa's Bill Powers, 1:01.8 and David Perhowski, Westfield, New Jersey, 1:02.6.

Ranked behind Schollander in the 200 yd. freestyle was Evanston's outstanding junior, Bill Swisher, 1:46.8 and Mike Wall, Blackford, Calif., 1:47.7.

Brad Lindeblad trailed Schollander in the 100 yd. freestyle 48.5 followed by 3 men at 48.6—Phil Chase, New Trier; Edward Mossotti, Mehlville, Mo., and Roben Waples, Palo Alto.

In the 400 yd. freestyle, Swisher 3:52.0 and John Nelson, a junior from Pompano Beach, Florida, 3:54.3, trailed the Santa Clara champion's time.

The divers are listed alphabetically, but among those making the All America selections were: James Askins, Wichita South, Kansas; Fred Brown, Seton Hall, New Jersey; Steve Fancher, High Line, Wash.; Julian Krug, Blackford, Calif.; Chuck Stenback, Ferndale, Mich.; Douglas Todd, New Trier.

Dave Robertson's New Trier high school climbed back to the top of the high school heap as their relay teams placed first in both the freestyle and medley.

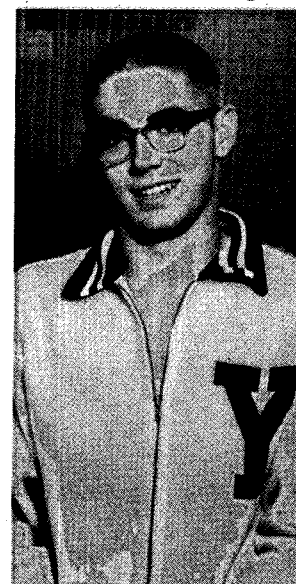

11 NATIONAL JC MARKS SET

ILMAN AND WEBB PACE FOOTHILL TO TOP JC ALL-AMERICA HONORS

Walnut, California—Gary Ilman, practically a one man swim team and freshman teammate Ken Webb each received four first place All America selections on the 1964 All America Junior College Team, reported John Stonebraker, Mt. San Antonio College statistician.

Ilman, who was runnerup to Steve Clark in the National Indoor Championships in the 100 and 200 yd. freestyle, again proved that JC swimming has a place in the U.S. swimming picture, as his time of 1:44.6 for 200 yd. freestyle, a first place ranking in the 1964 Junior College All America, would have ranked him second in the 1964 NCAA All America list. This time and his other firsts established new JC national records.

Ilman, who leaves Coach Nort Thornton's power-packed Owl squad, won first place ranking in the Junior College All America for the 100 yd. freestyle (47.4) and the 100 yd. butterfly, 51.7, both times equal to a 4th place in the NCAA rankings, and also placed first in the 500 yd. freestyle, 4:54.0, good enough for 5th if he had competed in an NCAA 4-year school.

Ilman was nominated for the second ranking in the 50 yd. freestyle, behind Bakersfield Junior College's Bob Boyer, 21.8. Ilman had a best of 22.2. For Boyer, it was a new JC national mark.

Ken Webb, a one time teammate of Don Schollander, when both competed at Multnomah AC, also set 4 National JC records as he too claimed 4 first place rankings on the 1964 Junior College All America. The Foothill College freshman's new records were: 1650 yd. freestyle, 17:23.1; 200 yd. butterfly, 1:56.5; 200 yd. individual medley, 2:02.0; and 400 yd. individual medley, 4:19.2.

Webb's great times in the freestyle, butterfly and 400 yd. medley would have earned him 5th, 4th and 3rd place rankings respectively on the NCAA All America, if competing for an NCAA 4-year college, and at the varsity level. Webb is certain to further lower his new standards before he leaves Foothill in 1965.

The outstanding performances by Ilman and Webb, along with the fine efforts Ken Merten, Valley JC breaststroke ace, make it almost a certainty that there will be some junior college swimmers on the Olympic team.

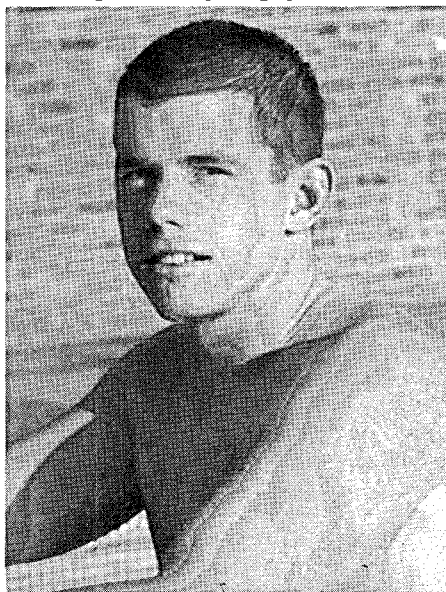
Merten, as expected, outstroked the field in the 100 yd. and 200 yd. breaststroke All America selections, with 1:01.5 and 2:16.1 clockings. He finished 2nd in the National AAU Indoor 100 yd. breaststroke and 3rd in the 200 yd. event. Like Ilman, he also repeated from 1963 as a JC All America.

Pete Maxwell, Santa Monica CC, was named first on the JC All American 200 yd. backstroke, 2:05.0 and Terry Craig, Orange Coast, made his first place ranking with a 56.6 clocking for the 100 yd. dorsal event. Craig's time is the new JC national record.

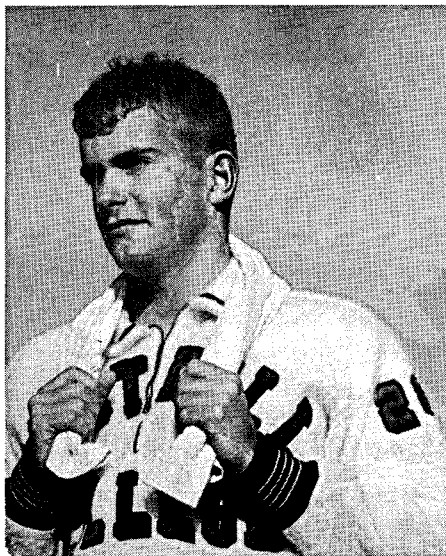
Nort Thornton, who has built a powerhouse at Foothill in the three short years that he has been there, saw his 400 yd. medley relay team and 400 yd. freestyle team rip the JC national standards with 3:43.2 and 3:16.9 clockings, respectively. Thus his mermen took 10 of the 15 first place All America rankings.

In diving, Cerrito's Larry Andreason led the field, with Alan Kara, LA Valley, not far behind.

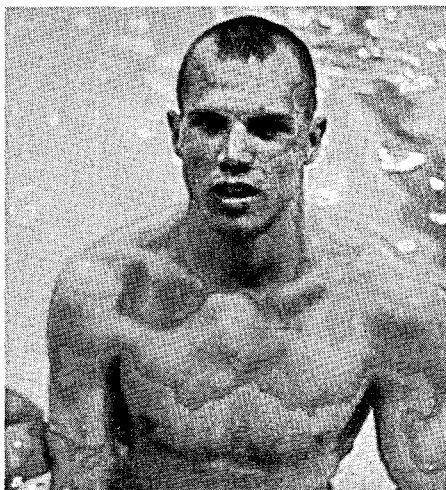

KEN WEBB, FOOTHILL COLLEGE

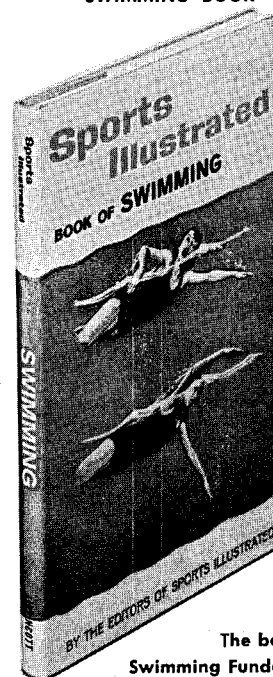

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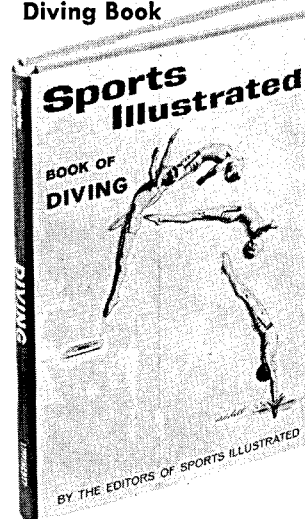

CLARK, SAARI AND INDIANA GAIN MOST PLACES IN '64 NCAA ALL AMERICA

The NCAA All-America Selection Committee (Bill Brooks, Harvard; Art Solow, Colo. St.; Jay Markley, Okla.; Art Adamson, Texas A & M; Peter Daland U.S.C.; Pat Earey, No. Car.; Ed Gabel, West Mich.; and John Higgins, UNS) in selecting the 1964 NCAA All-America team, feel that it is the strongest All-America ever selected. Not only were the top times faster in every event, but there is considerably more pressure from underneath.

The 50-yard freestyle is a case in point. Twelve men tied for a swim off for sixth place in the NCAA Championships. The time range in those spots 21.9 to 22.1. If we had included all of those in the swim off on this All-America, plus all of those having gone 22.1 or better through the year, we would have had 23 men make the 50 yd. freestyle in this year's selections.

We decided to cut off with the sixth place qualifier and all those who were better thru the year in bonified top flight competition, and still gave us nine men 21.9 or better.

The winner of the event in the NCAA is automatically selected for the top spot on the All-America. The second place winner gets the nod for number two. After that it is primarily on the basis of verified times through the season.

Steve Clark, Yale junior, made the team in four individual events and one relay. Two of his spots were first place, 100 and 200 yd. freestyle.

SC's sophomore, Roy Saari made the team in four individual events and one relay. Three of Saari's places were first, 500 freestyle, 1650 yd. freestyle and 200 yd. individual medley.

Bill Craig, USC sophomore was the only other man to take more than one top spot in the individual events, as he swept the 100 and 200 yd. breaststroke events.

The Indiana Hoosiers placed men in 34 spots on the All-America, plus two relays out of a total of 155 individual places and 20 relays. USC placed 20 men and both relays, followed by Yale, 17 men and both relays. This represents approximately 1/2 of the individual places and 6 of the 20 relays.

The spread of talent was fairly even, with a slight edge going to the middle west, where Michigan placed men in 13 places and one relay, Minnesota in 6 spots and two relays, and Ohio State in nine individual places.

Indiana, USC, Yale, Michigan, Minn., and Ohio State placed men in 109 individual All-America places, and contributed 9 of the 20 relays.

Three schools dominated the diving selections, Indiana, Michigan and Ohio State. Iowa State was the lone outsider to crack the diving All-America rankings.

EDWARDS, JOHNSON... WILLISTON TOP PREPS ALL AMERICANS

Lawrenceville, New Jersey—Jim Edwards, a junior at Williston Academy, Tom Johnson, Malvern Prep and Coach Wilmot S. Babcock's Williston Academy swam off with most of the top honors in the 1964 NISCA Prep School All American Swimming Team, compiled by Philip G. Pratt, coach of the Lawrenceville School. It was a great year for prep swimming as 7 new records went into the record book.

Edwards, a diabetic, who has been competing for just a few years, and hails from New Hampshire, placed first in the 200 yd. freestyle with a record time of 1:48.3. He also earned first place in the 50 yd. freestyle, 22.2. In addition to the two first place rankings, he was ranked 2nd in the 100 yd. freestyle, 48.6, second in 400 yd. freestyle, 4:00.0 and anchored Williston's (Leigh Adams, W. Charbonneau and Barry Wemple) 200 yd. medley relay to first in a national prep record of 1:42.0. Williston placed second to Punahou in the 200 yd. freestyle relay, 1:31.0, and Edwards anchored this quartet.

Malvern Prep, coached by Larry Palacio, shared the spotlight with the Easthampton school, as two of their swimmers garnered three first place rankings. Tom Johnson ranked first in both the 200 yd. individual medley and 400 yd. freestyle, and set new national prep marks in the process. Johnson clocked a 2:02.6 for the medley and his 3:54.5 for the 400 knocked over 5-seconds from Steve Rerych's old mark set in 1963. He tied for third in the 50 yd. freestyle, 22.4 and sixth in the 200 yd. freestyle, 1:32.5.

Mike Fitzmaurice, Johnson's teammate, lowered the 100 yd. freestyle national prep record to 48.5 for his first place ranking and placed second to Edwards in the 200 yd. freestyle 1:49.4.

Allen Richardson, Punahou School in Hawaii, and Phil Riker, Lawrenceville School, New Jersey, were the only prepsters to repeat their 1963 first place rankings. Richardson set a new prep mark of 1:01.7 to rip his old mark of 1:04.0 set last year.

Phil Riker, lowering his 1963 mark of 52.7 to 52.0, placed first in the 100 yd. butterfly, ranked sixth in the 100 yd. freestyle, 49.9, and third in the 200 yd. freestyle 1:50.6.

Peekskill Military Academy's Charles Wigo earned first place ranking in the 100 yd. backstroke, recording 56.5, fastest time for a prep swimmer this past season.

In the diving event, four men repeated as All Americans, William Baird, Haverford, Tom Hutton, Fork Union M.A., Timothy Mahoney, Andover and Tom Paxton, Lawrenceville. Newcomers to the All America listing included Clyde Alexander, Culver, Pete Buckley, Bellarmine, Tom Cleveland, Hill, and Mike Mayfield, Pine Crest.

Tom Haynie's Punahou School made first place listing for the 200 yd. freestyle relay. The quartet of William Dick, John Madison, David Padgett and Mike Miles clocked 1:30.7.

Steve Rerych, Peekskill MA's ace who ranked first in two events in 1963, placed fourth in the 200 yd. freestyle, 1:50.8, 2nd in the 200 yd. individual medley, 2:03.8 and third in the 100 yd. freestyle, 48.8.

Bakersfield, Calif.—Russ Webb and Gary Ilman paced Foothill College to the team crown at the State Junior College Swimming and Diving Championships at Bakersfield College May 7-9 by scrambling to three victories apiece. Webb raced to National Junior College records in 400 yd. individual med., (sc), 4:21.5, defeating Jerrold Sheeley, El Cam., 4:38.2; 200 yd. butterfly, 1:56.5, downing teammate Gary Langendoen, 2:00.5, and 200 yd. individual medley, 2:02.0, besting Ken Merten, Valley, 2:05.8. Ilman, a 1-man team, eclipsed a National Junior College record in the 100 yd. butterfly, 52.6, downing Sheeley, El Camino, 54.3; 200 yd. freestyle, 1:45.7, topping Mike Garibaldi, Foothill, 1:48.8, and tied another in the 100 yd. freestyle, 47.7, besting Bob Boyer, Bakersfield, 48.5. In the final scoring Foothill wound up with 141 points, easily outpointing Orange Coast, 54, and Valley, 52.

Ken Merten of Valley swept breaststroke action with a pair of tallies. Ken copped the 100 yd. event in 1:02.3, followed by Barry Goldfarb, Santa Monica, 1:03.7, and Alan Harrison, Bakersfield, 1:03.9, who tied for second, and 200 yd. race, 2:16.6, easily trouncing Harrison, 2:24.4.

The meet's only other double winner came in diving competition as Larry Andreason of Cerritos accomplished the feat. Andreason copped the one meter, 428.05, beating Alan Kara, Valley, 354.30, and three meter, 503.85, setting a Meet record and again whipping Kara, 382.65.

Foothill's Mike Garibaldi and Bakersfield's Boyer rolled to National Junior College record performances. Mike notched a mark in the 1650 yd. freestyle, 17:23.4, turning back Pat Glasgow, Orange Coast, 17:25.3. Boyer blazed to a new mark in the 50 yd. freestyle, 21.9, disposing of Schupbach, Chaffey, 22.4.

Foothill's crack 400 yd. freestyle relay aggregate demolished a National Junior College record in that event. The team of Langendoen, Horack, Garibaldi, and Browne covered the distance in 3:16.9. The 400 yd. medley relay crew of Southard, Webb, Ilman, and Browne finished in 3:43.2.

Terry Craig of Orange Coast equalled a National Junior College standard in the 100 yd. backstroke. Terry was timed in 56.6, defeating Pete Maxwell, Santa Monica, 57.0.

Glasgow of Orange Coast and Maxwell of Santa Monica picked up firsts. Glasgow was successful in the 500 yd. freestyle, 4:57.9, obliterating a National Junior College mark, downing Diefenderfer, Foothill, 4:58.1. Maxwell prevailed in the 200 yd. backstroke, 2:05.0, besting Terry Craig, 2:05.4.
